2. Create a free account
3. A Prezi is public unless you sign up for a private account
4. Choose a theme/template
5. Fill in the information on the chosen template
6. Choose a path for the order of the presentation

2. Create a free account

1. Go to apps store (or wherever you purchase your apps) and download the free reader app if you don't already have it.
2. Qr-code-generator.com
  - Go to the website
  - In the box under create your QR code for free, choose text
  - Type your information, directions, etc. in the box
  - Create QR code
  - Code will appear in the box to the right
  - Download and save it – label it
  - Print

1. Go to [www.getkahoot.com](http://www.getkahoot.com)
  2. Sign up for a free account
  3. Create a quiz, discussion, survey
  4. PIN is generated
  5. Go to My Kahoots
  6. Sign in and Launch
  7. Have audience join with Game PIN
  8. Members can send a nickname or you can have them use their real name
  9. Click OK, go!
  10. A countdown will begin as members enter the choice on their device. Responses will be shown on screen and results and points tabulated.

## Instagram

### 1. Instagram.com-Adding photos

- If you don't already have it, go to the apps store and download the free app
- Click the share tab to add photos. It is the large camera-shaped tag in the center.
- To use/add pictures from your own photo album, click layered photo icon from bottom left to select a photo from your albums, then tap to select. Click next to move on to the next screen. You can choose to edit, apply a filter, or add information
- To take a new photo for Instagram, click the share button; click the camera icon on the bottom to take a picture. Click next to move on to the next screen

## How to use Instagram

### Basics

#### 1. Scroll through your feed.

To get to the *Feed* tab, tap on the icon that looks like a house to the very left. From the "Feed" tab you can scroll through posts by all of the users you are following.

#### 2. Look at the popular tab.

These are typically the Instagram photos with the most 'likes'. The popular tab is visualized by a star icon.

To search for users and hashtags, go to the popular tab and type into the search bar at the top.

#### 3. View your news and updates.

Anytime someone likes one of your photos, comments on one of your photos, follows you, or tags you in a photo, you will be notified under your 'News' tab. This is the small comment-box icon with a heart in the center, the third tab over. If someone actively likes, comments, or follows you while you are on Instagram, a small orange heart, comment bubble, or profile shape will appear just above your 'news' tab.

#### **4. Like and comment other people's photos.**

Whether you are scrolling through your news feed or viewing images under the popular tab, you can show your interest by liking or commenting on them. To like a photo, you can either press the heart shaped button just under the photo, or you can double tap the image. To comment on a photo, click the small comment-bubble icon and type your comment when the keyboard appears.

#### **5. View your own profile.**

To see an archive of your uploaded photos as well as a complete list of who you're following and who your followers are, you can visit your profile tab on the far right side (a square icon with a bubble and stripes inside of it).

### **Adding Photos**

#### **1. Add your photos to Instagram.**

Clicking the "Share" tab will allow you to add photos. This is the large camera-shaped tab in the center at the bottom of the screen.

#### **2. Take a new photo for Instagram.**

If you don't have the photo you want to post in your photo albums, you can take a new photo and upload it directly. After clicking the 'share' button, click the camera icon in the center to snap a photo. (This requires a device with a camera such as the iPhone or an Android phone.) Click 'next' to move onto the next screen.

You can also click the small icon on the bottom right to enable and disable your device's flash, if supported.

**3. Upload a photo from your photo albums.** You can add this by clicking the layered photo icon from the bottom left to select a photo from your photo albums, then tap it to select it. Click 'next' to move onto the next screen.

#### **4. Edit your photo.**

You can choose to rotate your photo, add a frame, create a blurring effect, or brighten the photo by selecting each of the corresponding icons (in that order) on the screen. If you decide you don't like the edits you've done, simply click the icon again to revert the edit.

#### **5. Apply a filter to your photo.**

Click on the intertwined squares at the bottom left to choose a picture to work with, then select a filter from the choices that appear. If you decide you don't want

any filters, the tile on the far left will revert your image back to the ‘normal’ settings. Click”Next” when you are finished.

**6. Add information to your image.**

Enter a brief description of your photo in the “What?” text input field. You don’t have to include anything, but are only able to add a description before you post the photo. Add hashtags here to provide a searchable query for others to find your photo.

**7. Share your photo outside of Instagram.**

You can share your photo on any other social networks you use underneath “Sharing” and clicking on the social network that you want to post your photo on.

**8. Click "Done" to complete the process and post your photo.**

Your photo will appear in your “Feed” and also the feed of other Instagram users that are following you.
