Re: GA TECH info. Sunday, 1/7

Happy New Year! I am sorry that I missed the wonderful performance before the holidays. I've heard what a great job the kids did and I got a video! I hope you are looking forward to our first performance of 2018 at Georgia Tech, I am! If you and your juggler can go, you will not be disappointed. If you can't be there early, but see you can make it by 2:15 or so ... come on and join the fun!

There are a few things I need to tell you, so please read the rest of this form and call me if you have any questions.

Our performance is at the 2 pm women's game. Tickets may be purchased at the ticket office at Gate 1 entrance (this entrance is facing 10th St.). Tickets are \$7.00 each unless you tell them the group name of Peeples and then you will get them for \$3.00. All students under 19 will get in for free, but need a ticket for the fire marshal to know how many people are in the building. **YOUR JUGGLER WILL NEED A TICKET** as well. I will have tickets for them or you can pick up one at the ticket office if you do not see me. Performance will be around 2:30 PM. Please have your child at the game **by 1:30 if at all possible.** (that is a Georgia Tech request). I will be just inside the 10th St doors helping you find the rest of the group until 1:45 and then another juggler parent will be handling that job while I take care of the music and other logistics. If you come in late, you will need to go in at gate 1 and come inside and look for us. We will all sit together just to the left of the fenced off area where the season ticket holders sit. Your juggler must have on their shirt and blue jeans to perform. Please have your juggler bring their three balls. We will be a long way from home.

If you have trouble transporting your Juggler to GA Tech, feel free to call and make arrangements with another Juggler's parents to bring him/her for you, however, know that students will not be released to anyone other than their own parents or the person they came with, without written permission. Make sure you send a note with your child on the date of the performance if he/she is transported by another parent. The team members will not leave the arena after the performance and therefore we will not need a sign out process. Your juggler will come up the stairs to you.

Another very important matter: All parents are responsible for their child's whereabouts until I take them out of the gym to line up in the practice gym. That will be at 10 minutes left in the half.

Parking is a bit of a problem at Tech. When you turn onto 10th street, you might be able to park in the first lot you come too, east of the stadium. If not, go past the arena, take a left, go all the way to the end of the street, and there is a parking garage right in front of you. McCamish Lot if you need to ask someone.

DIRECTIONS: North on I 85 into downtown. Take the 10th St. exit. At the top of the ramp (Light) turn left, and go back over the interstate. The arena is on your left.

Please let me know if your juggler will be attending or not.

Our next performance is on Friday, Jan 12 at Whitewater High. I am sorry but you will receive another informational email in a day or two about how to purchase tickets to this event.
